

Dear Concord Elementary Families:



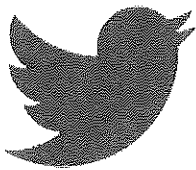

Concord Elementary Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures 2018-2019

Concord Families,

Safety of students is our number one priority and it takes staff and families working together to ensure the safety of our students. It is important that the following drop-off and pick-up procedures are followed daily.

Drop-Off/Pick-Up Safety Procedures: Doors Open at 8:45 and Dismissal is 3:25

- Parents should enter the Concord Elementary driveway off State Route 718 and use the main drive towards the front main office doors. **718 gets very busy at the beginning and end of each day and it is important that cars do not wait on 718 to enter the parking lot (safety issue).** Please either enter the parking lot and park and walk up to the doors or wait on the side of McKaig Avenue until there is an opportunity to pull directly into the lot. We've consulted with city engineers and have decided to add additional road marking and signage to indicate the end of our waiting zone and the new "No Stopping" zone on 718. **Safety is our number one priority! Please also avoid all left turns into the main drive if at all possible during drop-off and pick-up. This will allow traffic to flow smoothly.**
- Please park in the large front parking lot if you need to enter the building with your child. **The front small lot will be closed during arrival and dismissal times.** Students/Parents should not cross over the flow of traffic.
- Students need to exit cars in the drop zone marked by painted area and signs.
- Students **must** exit cars on the curbside of the car. Do not allow students to exit into the flow of traffic.
- After dropping off students, parents can exit back onto State Route 718.

Thank you for your cooperation in supporting this safety plan. Again, it takes staff and families working together to ensure the safety of our students.

Concord Elementary Parent Lunch Procedures 2018-2019

We invite all parents and families to visit and eat with their child during their scheduled lunch time! However, we do ask that the following procedures are followed when eating lunch with your child.

Lunch Procedures:

- Parents should enter the building using the front main office doors and sign in at the office.
- Please sit at the designated family table in the cafeteria.
- Your child may have **one** friend from their grade sit with you during lunch.
- Please sign out in the office before leaving the building.

Due to liability and safety, families are not permitted to attend outside or inside recess with students. After lunch, please say goodbye in the cafeteria and return to the office to sign out.



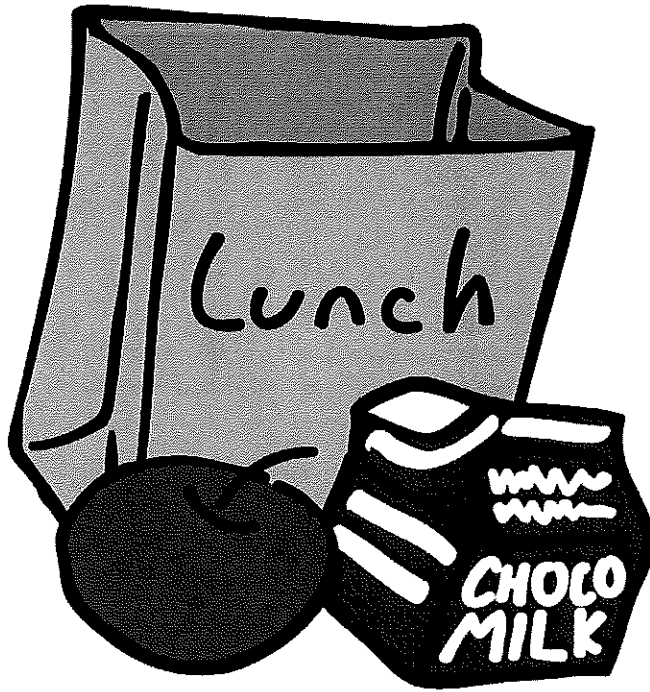
