

# TROY HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS HALL OF FAME CHARTER



## **I SECTION I PURPOSE**

The purpose of the Athletics Hall of Fame is to establish a method to honor outstanding student/athletes and individuals who have made significant and lasting contributions to the Troy Athletics Department program and the local community.

## **II SECTION II CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION**

Any individual of good character who has distinguished himself/herself through athletics achievement in the areas of coaching, administration, officiating, or as a fan. An individual may be nominated posthumously.

## **III SECTION III CRITERIA/QUALIFICATIONS**

### Student/Athletes

- Superior accomplishment as a student/athlete such as ALL-AREA, ALL DISTRICT, ALL STATE, ALL AMERICAN, or other significant awards.
- Graduate of Troy High School.
- Graduation from Troy High School at least eight (8) years prior to nomination.
- Continuing excellence at the amateur, collegiate, national or professional levels.
- Clearly demonstrates integrity, sportsmanship, ethics and citizenship before and after graduation.
- Academic and post college career accomplishments.

### Administrators/Coaches/Community Members

- Significant contributions made to the Athletics program, taking into account longevity, overall record and championships.
- Significant contributions to community or professional organizations at the state, national, or professional levels to promote athletics.
- Retirement from their position from the Troy City Schools.

## **IV SECTION IV NOMINATIONS**

Nominations shall be solicited by advertisement, announcements, or electronic communications. Nominations may be made by any individual.

Nominations must be submitted on the official nomination form by April 1 of each school year to be considered for induction the following school year.

Not more than 3 or 4 persons shall be inducted each year.

## **V SECTION V RECOGNITION**

Each inductee shall receive an award, inscribed with an appropriate symbol, his or her name, accomplishment, and year of induction.

Names of inductees, along with information about their contributions and accomplishments to the Troy Athletics program shall be permanently displayed in an appropriate area at Troy High School.

Inductions shall be held at a home varsity basketball game near the end of January on a Friday or Saturday.

## **VI SECTION VI HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE (SELECTION COMMITTEE)**

It shall be the primary duty of the committee to accept, screen and verify the documents that are submitted, and to then select the nominated applicants.

The committee shall consist of seven (7) members; two of which will be permanent members.

The permanent members shall be by the High School Principal or designee and the High School Director of Athletics.

The Hall of Fame Committee (Selection Committee) shall also include three (3) at large members, who will represent those who have graduated, or coaches, and/or employees who have or are employed by the Troy City Schools.

The terms of office of the Hall of Fame Committee, at-large committee members will be six (6) years.

The members of the Hall of Fame Committee shall elect a Chairperson and Secretary to serve two (2) years.

Should a member resign or otherwise become ineligible during a term, a replacement shall be elected by the committee.

## **VII SECTION VII SUB-COMMITTEE**

Sub-committees will be formed to handle the following responsibilities:

1. Compile the list of nominees with documentation concerning their accomplishments.
2. Prepare and plan procedures for the induction ceremony.
