

## **Clarification for COVID-19 Isolation and Quarantine Procedures**

### WHAT TO DO IF YOU HAVE COVID-19

- Stay home for the next 5 days regardless of symptoms or vaccination status.
- After 5 days:
  - You may return once you have been fever-free for 24 hours and your symptoms are improving - You may return to school but should wear a mask through day 10.

# WHAT TO DO IF YOU WERE EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID-19

• If you are symptom free, you may continue to attend school but must wear a mask for the next 10 days.

### <u>OR</u>

• Receive a negative test result between days 5 and 7. You may stop wearing a mask after 7 days with a negative test result.

#### <u>OR</u>

Do not attend school for the next 10 days.

Note: When masks are required, mask breaks are still permitted in various settings that don't put students in close-contact with others.
