RESOLUTION TO EXPAND EMPLOYMENT OF SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS CONSISTENT WITH AM. SUB. HOUSE BILL 409

Pursuant to the authority granted in Section 3 of Amended Substitute House Bill 409 of the 133rd General Assembly, signed by Governor DeWine on or about January 7, 2021, the Troy City Schools Board of Education authorizes the employment of substitute teachers, as-needed, who do not hold a post-secondary degree, as otherwise required pursuant to Ohio law and regulations, including Ohio Revised Code 3319.226 and 3319.30, Ohio Administrative Code Section 3301-23-44, and/or Board Policy, provided that all other applicable requirements and procedures, including successful completion of a criminal background check and evidence of a non-renewable temporary substitute teaching license issued by the Ohio Department of Education, have been satisfied. This is a temporary resolution of the Troy City Schools Board of Education, and the authority granted by this resolution extends from the effective date through June 30, 2021.
