

Andrea Brown Memorial Scholarship

One of the most pressing needs in higher education today is funding for college. Scholarships allow deserving students to attain their educational goals, meet their professional objectives and succeed to their fullest abilities. The Andrea Brown Memorial Scholarship was established by the Andrea Brown family for the purpose of assisting a college-bound Senior Band student to continue their education beyond high school. The recipient of the Andrea Brown Memorial Scholarship will receive a one-time gift of \$250.

The following document will outline Scholarship criteria and application deadlines.

Eligible students will meet the following criteria:

- Have participated in four years (8 semesters) of High School Band and be a graduating senior in good standing.
- Attending either a 2 year or 4 year college.
- Minimum of 3 years participation in Solo/Ensemble contests on a high school level.
- GPA of 3.2 or higher.
- Demonstrated good leadership qualities all four years of High School Band.

Please provide the Selection Committee with an essay entitled "The Positive Effect High School Band Has Made on My Life". Essay will be single-spaced and **no more** than half a page.

If selected, recipient may be required to present a letter of acceptance from the college of their choice.

Application and essay must be submitted to Troy High School Guidance Office by April 1.
