



The Jennie Webster Irie 4-H Scholarship Application 2019

We are pleased to make available again this year the Jennie Webster Irie 4-H Scholarship, established to honor Jennie Webster Irie as a charter member of the first 4-H chapter.

Two scholarships of \$1,000 each will be offered annually to graduating high school seniors residing in Champaign, Clark and Miami Counties who have been active in 4-H. The award must be used toward the tuition and other related educational expenses at an accredited two or four-year college.

- To be eligible for consideration, applicants must:
- Provide evidence of acceptance at an accredited college or university.
- Have a 2.5 cumulative grade point average on a scale of 4.0 points or greater.
- Submit a completed application form which must be accompanied by:
 - A recent letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, employer or guidance counselor*
 - A recent letter of recommendation from 4-H advisor or 4-H extension service staff familiar with the applicant's activities and involvement in 4-H.*

NOTE: *The required letters of recommendation listed above must **be provided by someone other than a relative.***

A most recent grade transcript

An essay: What are your education and career goals? What impact has 4-H had on your educational, career, or personal goals? (400 words minimum)

A copy of parent(s) signed Form 1040 pages 1 and 2 (please omit social security numbers) or your 1040 pages 1 and 2 if you are financially independent..

If applicable, an explanation of financial support for your higher education provided by a non-custodial parent or stepparent

Criteria for selection include: 4-H activity, community/church involvement, academic performance, and financial need, participation in school, recommendation and essay. **Note special emphasis is placed on the 4-H activities.**

Neatness and completeness of the application are taken into **consideration**.

The Graham Museum will convene the Selection Committee. The Committee may elect not to award scholarships if, in its judgment, suitable candidates cannot be identified.

Applications are available through the Champaign, Clark and Miami County Extension Offices and the 4-H Foundation.
