\$500 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

TBPA, Inc. (Troy Basketball Parents Association) has established a scholarship that will award \$500 to each senior basketball applicant meeting the criteria set forth below. The scholarship will be payable to the recipient's post-secondary institution in which he/she is enrolled. The scholarship must be issued within one (1) year from the date the scholarship is granted. In order to be considered for this scholarship, this application must be completed and returned to the **Troy High School Guidance Department** on or before **March 20th** of your senior year. Further, the following criteria will apply:

- 1) Applicants must have been a participant in the Troy City Schools basketball program for a minimum of four (4) years (during 7th -12th grades), including your senior year.

Transfer students who play in TCS basketball program during their junior and senior year may apply and will be considered by the Scholarship Selection Committee on a case-by-case basis.

- 2) Applicants must be planning to attend a post-secondary institution for the year immediately following your senior year of high school. (You do not need to be accepted to any particular institution at the time of application).
- 3) Applicants must be a student in good academic standing with a minimum grade point average of 2.75 at the time of application.
- 4) Applications must not have any offenses against the Troy Athletic Code of Conduct (7th-12th grade).
- 5) Applicants and/or your family must have participated each year (of basketball participation) by helping with planning and/or working at TBPA fundraising events.
- 6) Please submit a brief summary of your future plans (*Does not affect scholarship decision*).

The Troy High School Scholarship Selection Committee will determine the recipients of the scholarship. In doing so, the Committee will consider the first five criteria listed above. Financial need is not a consideration. By submitting this scholarship application, you are authorizing Troy High School to disclose your grade point average and any offenses concerning breaches of the *Athletic Code of Conduct*.
