



## Troy Volleyball Parents Association Scholarship Criteria and Application

1. Troy Volleyball Parents Association will make applications available to all senior players; in addition, a blank application will be available in the Guidance Department.
2. A subcommittee of the Troy Volleyball Parents Association will collect, compile, and evaluate all applications received on behalf of the Troy Volleyball Parents Association.
3. Applicants must be graduating seniors of Troy High School. A \$300 scholarship will be awarded to each senior who meets the requirements to assist the graduates to attend an accredited program at a two-year or four-year college, university, or technical school.
4. Eligibility requirements for the scholarship include:
  - a. Must have been a participant in the Troy City Schools volleyball program for at least 3 years (7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade), including senior year;
  - b. Must be planning to attend a post-secondary institution for the year immediately following the senior year of high school (need not have been accepted at time of application);
  - c. Must be a student in good academic standing with a minimum GPA of 3.00 at time of application;
  - d. Must not have any offenses against the Troy Athletic Code of Conduct for any year, 7<sup>th</sup>- 12<sup>th</sup> grades;
  - e. Must have participated by helping with, planning, and/or working at TVBA fundraising events (student or family) – **including assisting with the Spring JO tournament during senior year**; and
  - f. Must submit a brief summary of your future plans (does not affect scholarship decision).
5. Completed applications and essay must be submitted no later than April 1 to guidance department for verification of requirements above.
6. Once verified, Guidance Department will forward applications and essays to Troy Volleyball Parents.
7. Scholarship award certificates will be distributed to the recipients at Graduation Assembly by Athletic Director or Coach
8. Parents Association will cut and make available separate checks payable to award recipients & school to be attending to be delivered shortly after graduation. .
