**MONDAY, DECEMBER 21**

- 8:00 AM      **Breakfast included** at the hotel.  
Check out of the hotel.
- 9:00 AM      Transfer into the city and up Central Park West, traveling the length of beautiful **Central Park**, to **Morningside Heights**, and home to St. John the Divine.
- 10:45 AM     Have a **Special Performance** by the **Troy HS Choir** at the **Cathedral of St. John the Divine**. The largest cathedral in the world, the 601-foot-long nave is the length of two football fields, holding 5,000 worshippers, and the 162-foot-tall dome crossing, could comfortably contain the Statue of Liberty.

- 11:30 AM     Following your performance, transfer to **Grand Central Station** for lunch on your own. One of the world's great rail terminals, is New York's most visited with 500,000 people passing through it daily. It features 15 restaurants and over 40 shops, the New York City Transit Museum and a gourmet food market.

- 1:30 PM      Meet your guides and depart for an **afternoon sightseeing tour** of **Manhattan**. The tour will take you to the sites that made the Big Apple famous!
