GUIDELINES

About the fund: The Robert & Miriam Hartzell Scholarships were established at The Foundation through a grant from the Hartzell Norris Charitable Trust, Fifth Third Bank, trustee. The scholarships are made each year to a graduate from each of the following high schools: Lehman Catholic, Miami East, Piqua and Troy.

Qualifications: Applicants must attend a four-year college or university and be studying for a four-year degree or a degree designed for more than four years. Applicants must also be a student of one of the following high schools: Lehman Catholic, Miami East, Piqua and Troy. Winners will be determined based on leadership achievement and potential, scholastic achievement and potential, financial need and character assessment.

Award value: One scholarship of up to \$2,500 at each eligible school, renewable up to four years with continued full-time enrollment at a four-year college or university and a 3.0 grade point average.
